Dear Parents, We would like to remind those of you who require care for their children on the 14th August (pupil free day), to book online as soon as possible. We will be providing service on this day and it is very important that we have the right amount of staff to provide a quality and safe service for your children. This is why it is so important to book online.

It has come to our attention that we are having a lot of regular drop-ins; please ensure if you wish to utilise the service on a frequent basis, please book online as this will assist with staffing, catering food and activities for the children. Please note that permanent bookings do not roll over from term-to term, so please ensure that you have rebooked for term 4 should you require a permanent booking. It is also imperative that should you wish for your child to attend a BSC session please book online or contact the Coordinator directly on 0428 131 700 to inform of their attendance. This is to ensure children are in the correct areas and not attending if they are required to be at another activity, such as Band, T.O.M, Karate etc.

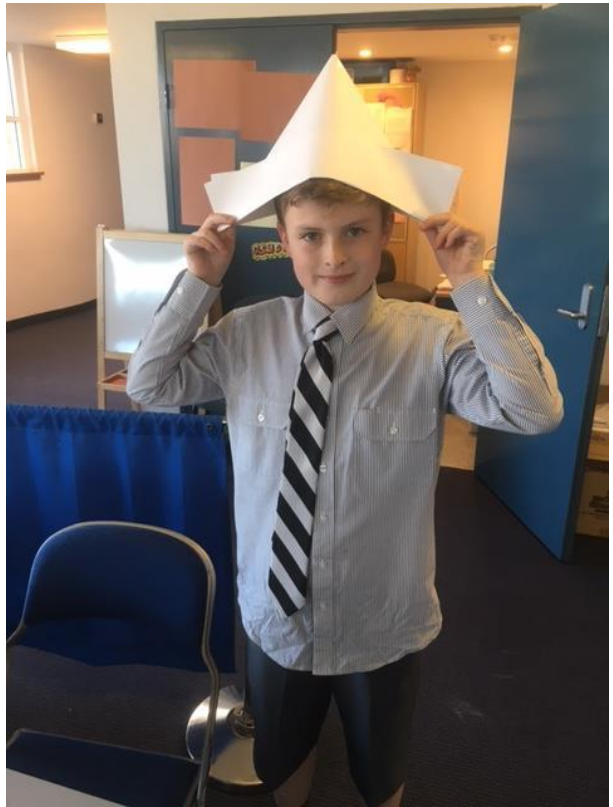
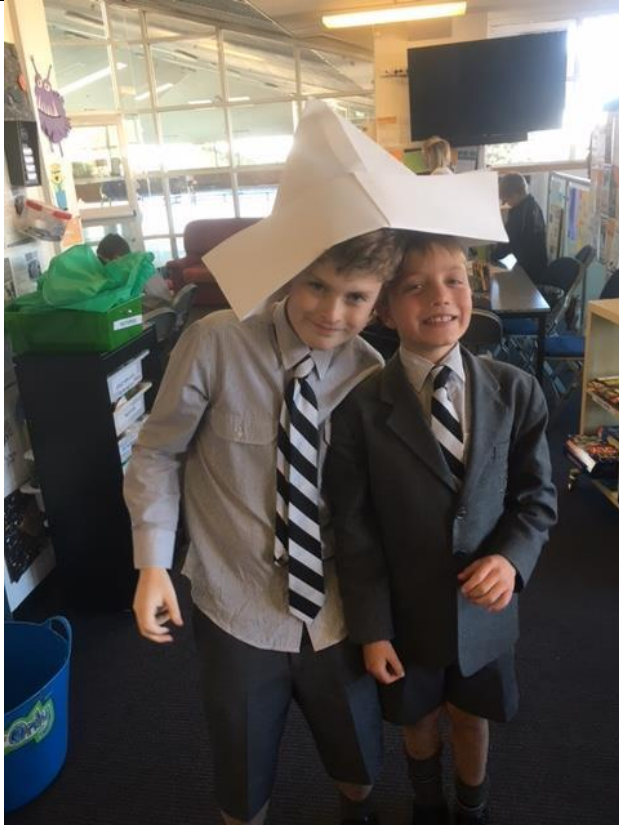
As always, the boys always have an opportunity to complete homework, and engage in activities of their choice.

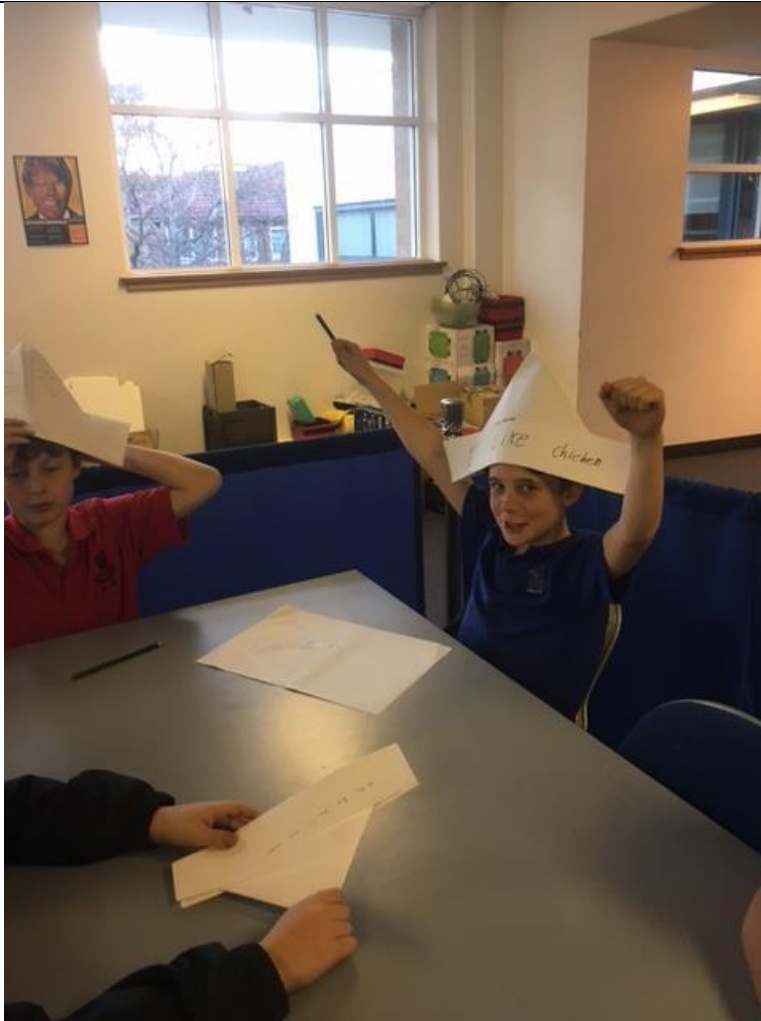
We would like to remind parents that if they would like to request for their boy/s to do homework at OSHClub, please inform a member of staff.
