St Patrick's College and Trinity Grammar Invitation Swimming Carnivals

This term the Newington Swimming Team will be participating in the Trinity Swimming Invitation on Friday 3 November and St Patrick's Invitation on Friday 10 November. These carnivals are conducted in a spirit of friendly competition and are aimed at providing our boys' additional opportunities to compete in swimming carnivals following the carnivals in Term 1. The carnivals will be held during Friday afternoons between 1:00pm – 3:00pm. For our Year 6 boys this will be their final opportunity to represent the Newington Preparatory Schools' in an Inter-School Carnival. For our younger boys this will be a valuable opportunity to experience competition against some of the best swimmers in the IPSHA.

Swim Squad

Swim squad will recommence week 2 of Term 4 on Tuesday 17 October. It will continue each Tuesday and Thursday morning until Thursday 23 November.

Positions are limited to 32 students in Term 4. Priority will be given to those boys who have trained with the swim squad all year. Any additional positions will be offered to students on a first in with permission note, first served basis. The Senior School Swimming Squad train in the pool at the same time during Term 4 and those boys moving on to the Senior School next year will have the opportunity to continue their swimming with this squad.

Term 4 Aquatics

The Wyvern House Aquatics Program will take place on Thursdays and Fridays over the next 5 weeks. The Wyvern House Aquatics Program is a compulsory component of the PDHPE Syllabus and all boys are required to attend and participate as part of their regular PE lessons. Recent trends across schools indicate an increasing number of boys lack basic water skills, which limits their enjoyment of aquatic activities. Swimming is one part of five key skills covered in the program, however it is essential skill used in all 5 areas. For Year 5 and Year 6 students, the program culminates in a surf day excursion. Permission notes will be sent home this week.

NZ Tour

During the holidays, 43 Year 6 students from both Newington Prep campuses, travelled to the South Island of New Zealand for a 9 day football and rugby tour. Mr Wilson, Mr Brunton, Mr Hazelton and Mr Lowrie were staffing the tour which involved games in Christchurch, Dunedin and Invercargill, before some fun activities in Queenstown.
