From 2000 to 2003 Professor Hickie was CEO of beyondblue: the national depression initiative and from 2003 to 2006 served as its Clinical Advisor. In 2003, he was appointed as the Executive Director of the Brain and Mind Research Institute. In 2006, Professor Hickie received the Australian Honours Award of Member (AM) for services to medicine in the development of key national mental health initiatives.

Professor Hickie was appointed to the Prime Minister's Australian National Council on Drugs in 2007, and has led the BMRI as a founding member of the new National Youth Mental Health Foundation (headspace). From 2008-2013, Professor Hickie is one of the first round of new NHMRC 2008 Australian Fellows. In July 2008 he was appointed to the Federal Health Minister's new National Advisory Council on Mental Health, and in November 2009 he received the Research Australia National Advocacy Award for his work in mental health.
