On behalf of the [Wyvern House P&F Father & Son Camp Committee](#) we thank you for registering for the 2012 Year 3-6 camp to be held at the **Broken Bay Sport & Recreation Centre**. Just an "hour's drive" and a 15-minute ferry ride away at the mouth of the Hawkesbury River it is the perfect place to enjoy the best of the "beach and bush" in one location.

Join us for a weekend of non-stop action including canoeing, bushwalking, archery, fencing, rock climbing, abseiling, raft building, team challenges and a campfire cookout. Or just chill at the beach. The camp features a 400m long beach with enclosed canoeing area, tennis, beach volleyball and basketball courts, covered barbecue facilities and picnic areas, dining room with open fireplace, bushwalking trails with an abundance of native flora, and fauna, plus Aboriginal rock carvings.

How to get there: All campers arrive by ferry which departs from Brooklyn at 6:30pm.
If you can't make the ferry, you will need to arrange for a Water Taxi. Contact us for details.



- Head north on the Newcastle Freeway (F3).
- As you cross the main bridge over the Hawkesbury River take the left hand exit to Mooney Mooney and Brooklyn.
- You will come to a roundabout behind the ambulance station.
- Go straight through the roundabout and head back to the old Pacific Highway. Turn right on the old Pacific Highway and cross back over the Hawkesbury River
- For Brooklyn take the second turn on the left and head all the way to the end of Brooklyn Road where you will see the wharf.
- Camp committee members will be on hand at the Brooklyn Public Wharf to assist you to unload your luggage and direct you to suitable parking. We suggest you car pool if possible.
- A cold buffet supper will be provided on your arrival at the camp on Friday. But there are excellent fish restaurant/cafes in Brooklyn if you want a hot meal and can get there early enough.

On Saturday (before and after lunch) and on Sunday morning there will be organized activities. You can select activities online about two weeks before camp. On Saturday night there will be a Damper & Spud Camp Fire Cookout (weather permitting). There will also be the opportunity to just relax on the beach, kick a ball around or explore the bush land surrounding the camp with your son.

- **Please pay as soon as possible to secure your place: \$250 for fathers & \$175 for each boy.**
- **You MUST also complete and return a Medical/Consent Form for you and your boy/s.**
