Timothy Pritchard (Year 6) plays club hockey for Glebe and was selected into the U13 Sydney representative team for 2013. During the recent school holidays, Hockey NSW held the U13 Boys State Championships over three days at Taree. The Sydney team competed in Division 1 and won all their games leading up to the grand-final. In a crucial pool match on the way to the Grand Final they had to come back from 2 goals to 0 down against Newcastle to win 3 goals to 2 with Timothy scoring the winning goal in the final 40 seconds. The team then played Tamworth in the grand-final and won handsomely 4 goals to 0. Timothy got the last goal in the game to put the icing on the results.

Following the State Championships, Timothy was fortunate enough to have been selected into the NSW U13 Boys State squad. Last weekend, he went to a further 8 hour trial at Erina to see if he could make either the NSW U13 State team or the NSW U13 State Development team. Very happily for Timothy, especially in the first of his two years at the U13 level, he was selected into the NSW U13 State Development team. He will participate with that team over seven days in the forthcoming school holidays against the Queensland State Development team at Coffs Harbour and Grafton.
