Dates for the trials will be held prior to normal sport training on Wednesday the 26th February and Monday the 3rd March. Boys will not need any special equipment to participate. Sydney South/East/Inner West NSW Primary Schools 7s Rugby Union Challenge

The Australian Rugby Union Development team has developed the Primary Schools 7's Rugby Union Challenge with the aim to provide you and your students a great rugby union experience for the end of Term 1. Newington College would like to introduce Year 4, 5 and 6 students with previous Rugby Union experience from Wyvern, to the exciting game of Rugby Union 7s, which will be played at the 2016 Olympics.

A squad of 20 boys will be chosen to represent Wyvern at the Sydney South Challenge on the 21st March at AR Hurst, Sylvania. We will enter 1 side of 10 for U/12's and 1 side of 10 for the U/10's competition. Trials for selection will be conducted Wednesday the 12th March and Monday the 17th March at the Senior School before regular sport. On these days, regular

playing equipment is required - boots/sports shoes, mouthguard, headgear etc. Interested boys are asked to put their name on the 7's trial sheet on the sports notice board.

IPSHA Football Trials

The IPSHA football trials will be held on 25th March at North Turramurra. Wyvern will be asked to submit up to 5 boys to attend the IPSHA trials. In order to select 5 boys to attend, we will be holding training sessions at the senior school. Dates for the trials will be held prior to normal sport training on Monday the 10th and Wednesday the 12th March. Interested boys are asked to add their name to the IPSHA football list on the sport notice board. Please remember that these trials are necessary to find our most talented and skillful players to compete at the next level.

FUTSAL

Wyvern will enter 2 teams for the Football NSW (FNSW) Futsal 2014 Schools Regional Championships. This year Wyvern will be competing in the Sutherland Regional Championship towards the end of Term 2, held 23rd May.
