### *Pupil Free Day Update*

A few parents have been asking if day care will be occurring on the upcoming pupil free day, Friday June 6<sup>th</sup> 2014. Unfortunately, at this stage, we do not have enough bookings for day care to go ahead. If you do require day care for Friday June 6<sup>th</sup> then you need to book your children in as soon as possible to ensure that the service is run. The final notification regarding if the day service will go ahead, will be delivered by close of business on Tuesday June 3<sup>rd</sup>. If you do not book your children online and the service is therefore not run, you will not be able to bring your unbooked children in last minute on Friday June 6<sup>th</sup> as OSHClub staff will not be on site. To those who have booked children in for day service on Friday June 6<sup>th</sup>, unfortunately, it may be necessary to make alternative care arrangements for this day.

Time: 7.00am - 6.00pm

Cost: \$13.56 - \$55.00 per child (not including 50% tax rebate)

How to book: Prior to Tuesday June 3<sup>rd</sup>, please log in to your account at [www.oshclub.com.au](http://www.oshclub.com.au) and book in under the AFTERCARE bookings tab.

- If you are not an existing customer you will need to register your child with OSHClub at [www.oshclub.com.au](http://www.oshclub.com.au) and submit all up to date immunisation records.

What happens: Loads of fun for all ages including arts and crafts, active group games, indoor and outdoor sports, board games, construction and a film.

- Parents can decide if they would like their child to bring their iPad or tablet for use during short scheduled screen time - On doing this you accept full responsibility for your child's device.

What to bring: Breakfast (if necessary), morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea. Day service is quite long, so please remember to pack enough food and drink to last your child for the time they are here. Please also provide your child with a drink bottle and appropriate clothing, this includes a hat, sweater and comfortable shoes to be worn during sports.

### *Further Important Information for this Day*

- Once you have booked there are NO REFUNDS for cancellations.
- A \$10 late booking fee applies for any casual attendances on the day – although to ensure the best staff-to-child ratio PLEASE aim to book prior to Tuesday June 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- All regular before and after school care bookings have been removed.
