### **CIS Cross Country – June Eastern Creek – Thursday 11 June 2015**

The CIS Cross Country Championships took place at Eastern Creek, with 3 Wyvern students joining hundreds of others from around NSW. Matthew Torrible and Henry Isherwood competed in the 10 years event over the 2km course. Both boys were toward the front of the pack at the halfway mark, with Henry and Matthew pushing hard. The boys can be very proud of their efforts which did not decline over the remainder of the race, with Henry 39th overall and Matthew 45th overall.

Bili Robertson was the 3rd Wyvern student involved in the 11 years event over a gruelling 3km's. Bili has had great success at this event in recent years, but his age group has many excellent runners capable of winning on their day. Bili positioned himself well early, running comfortably in the top 4 runners. Past halfway, Bili was in 2nd place before one of his competitors made a quick move up an incline pushing Bili back to 3rd. But like a true champion, Bili responded over the last kilometre to hold the lead when it counted, winning his race by around 10 metres. This is the 3rd year in succession that Bili has been named as CIS champion in his age division. This achievement is certainly very special, given the standard of competition at this event. Bili will now progress to the NSWPSA Cross Country Championships to be held in July.

When prompted enter **Newington College Wyvern Prep** from the drop down list of schools. If you are asked for a password to register please enter “**Wyvern**”

A trophy and a prize of \$300 will go to the school with the fastest aggregate time. Any number of students can enter but only the first 3 will be included in the total. There is no requirement to enter a special team, but they all need to put in the

same “team name” on the second page of the registration.

If you register on-line early you will be sent your race bib, with timing chip attached in the mail. Then all you have to do is turn up on the day, and walk or run and have fun!
