Athletics

The Newington Preparatory Schools Inter-House Athletics Carnival is to be held Week 1 of Term 3 on Wednesday 25th of July. At the carnival, apart from the 100m and 200m events which are heats followed by finals, the remaining events will be straight finals with the 800m finalists and high jump winners already determined from trials held prior to the carnival. This means boys must run as fast as they can in the heats of the 100m and 200m. Otherwise you may win your heat but fail to make the final, based on time.

All parents are invited to come along to support the boys on this very fun day. Parents are able to transport their boys directly to and from the carnival as long as this is noted for class teachers on the permission slip. Permission notes for the 2018 Newington Preparatory Schools Inter-House Athletics Carnival went out last week and must all be returned to class teachers by Friday 29 June.
