Winter Sport Term 3

- Punctual for games – arriving **at least 30** minutes prior to the start of the scheduled game.
- Ensure that correct Newington sports uniform is worn (this includes playing equipment and safety equipment).

Athletics

The Newington Preparatory Schools Inter-House Athletics Carnival is to be held Week 1 of Term 3 on Wednesday 24 July. At the carnival, apart from the 100m and 200m events which are heats followed by finals, the remaining events will be straight finals with the 800m finalists and high jump winners already determined from trials held prior to the carnival. This means boys must run as fast as they can in the heats of the 100m and 200m. Otherwise you may win your heat but fail to make the final, based on time.

All parents are invited to come along to support the boys on this very fun day. Parents are able to transport their boys directly to and from the carnival as long as this is noted for class teachers on the permission slip. Permission notes for the 2019 Newington Preparatory Schools Inter-House Athletics Carnival went out last week and must all be returned to class teachers by Friday 28 June.

The 800m finalists have now been decided. These finals will be the first events contested at the athletics carnival, boys below need to be on the first bus leaving Wyvern at 7.00am or arriving by 7.30am if travelling with parents.
