Term 4 Aquatics

The Wyvern House Aquatics Program will take place on Mondays and Tuesdays over the next 5 weeks. The Wyvern House Aquatics Program is a compulsory component of the PDHPE Syllabus and all boys are required to attend and participate as part of their regular PE lessons. Recent trends across schools indicate an increasing number of boys lack basic water skills, which limits their enjoyment of aquatic activities. Swimming is one part of five key skills covered in the program, however, it is essential skill used in all 5 areas. For Year 5 and Year 6 students, the program culminates in a surf day excursion.
